

Puzzle wiring for desks with Tower CPU's



Set computers into place.



Monitor wires:

Electrical plug from monitor goes down into grommet hole but stays in between the layers – does not go through 2nd layer. Let the plug dangle out in the keybd. area for now.



Wire from monitor to computer goes down through both layers and connects to CPU. Any excess length should be coiled neatly and stored between the desk layers.



CPU wires:

Electrical plug from CPU goes up the 5" hole in bottom layer and for now sits dangling in the keybd. area along with plug from monitor.



Wires from keyboard and mouse go through the sandwich area between the top 2 desk layers and down through the 5" hole in 2nd layer to plug into CPU. Again, take any excess lengths of wire neatly coiled and put them into sandwich area so nothing is dangling in unsightly fashion.



Internet wires - in one large bundle should go from outlet into the sandwich area and should run through the sandwich area from desk to desk. An internet wire should not emerge from this sandwich area until it reaches the 5" hole directly above the particular computer to which it will be connected.



Speaker wires will have to stay on desk top then will drop down through grommet hole and 5" hole to connect to computer. Any excess length should be placed in the sandwich area.



Now go back and run **power bars** through the sandwich area, plugging the electrical plugs that are currently resting in keybd. area into them as you go. You can plug one power bar into the next to get sufficient length to run down a whole row of desks. If there are a lot of computers you may want to run one string of power bars for the left side and one string for the right side.



They may choose to turn all the computers on and off by hitting the switches on the power bar, so make sure the power bars can be easily reached from various keyboard areas and that they can then push the power bar back into sandwich area so all wiring is out of sight.

Now go under the desks and firmly bundle all the wires going up from CPU and fasten them to back leg so everything is neat and tidy. No dangling ugly loops of wire.
